The John Green House is one of the oldest standing sandstone buildings in Nyack and an outstanding example of the style of design and construction used by the early settlers of Dutch descent in the Hudson Valley. The house has been placed on the New York State and National Registers of Historic Places. John Green's contributions to Rockland County's future were broad and impactful. From helping to form the first steamboat service from Nyack in the 1820s to establishing a connecting roadway between Nyack and Suffern which later became Route 59, John Green was a visionary who always had his eye on the future.
